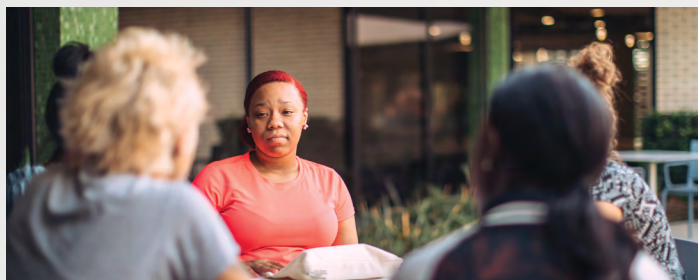

2023 YEARS IN REVIEW 2024

In 2023 and 2024, we strengthened our foundation to reach new heights.

We took action on our operational assessment and strategic plan to strengthen our membership, grantmaking and operations. Drawing on the social capital of our Members, we recruited the largest number of new Members since our founding in 2001 and conducted a matching challenge that led to our largest grants distribution in history: \$750,000.



Membership Growth

Leveraging the power of social capital, we kicked off our "Fundraising" efforts, engaging current Members to recruit new Members, and led a matching challenge to grow our grants pool.



Grantmaking Reach

WGA cast a wide net to reach new and diverse grantees, with 74 applicants requesting \$3 million in 2024, including grassroots nonprofits and about 25% first-time applicants. WGA made grants in all six counties that we serve.



Strategic Planning

Building on our operational assessment, a Member-led task force, Project Possible, took a fresh look at our work and recommended a series of actions to assure sustainability and success.



Research & Focused Giving

A group of Members began engaging grantees, learning from experts and reviewing research to develop recommendations for WGA's next grantmaking focus.

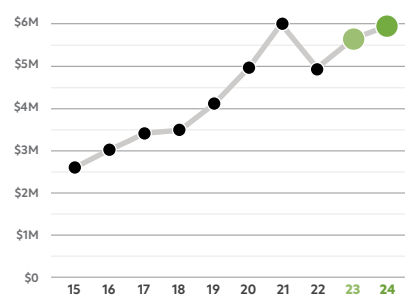
