Early Childhood

Childcare Providers in Duval County

- The Community Foundation will invest in curriculum and curriculum support for high quality childcare settings.
- Grants of \$2,500-\$5,000 will be made for work for one year

The Arts

Individual Artists—Art Ventures Fund

- The Community Foundation seeks to invest in individual artists who are pursuing the next step in their artistic development.
- Grants of up to \$3,500 will be awarded for one year
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and reside in Duval, Clay, Nassau, St. Johns or Baker County.

Small Arts Organizations—Art Ventures Fund

- The Community Foundation seeks to invest in capacity building and professional development so small arts organizations in Duval, Clay, Nassau, St. Johns and Baker County can sustain their programming for the long term.
- Grants of up to \$5,000 for Capacity Building will be awarded for one year
 - Applications for Capacity Building grants are due by 5 p.m. on **May 15, 2015** for grants beginning September 15, 2015.
- Grants of up to \$2,500 for Professional Development will be awarded for one year beginning **on January 15, 2015 and on an ongoing basis until funds are expended.**

Visual Arts in St. Augustine—Dr. JoAnn Crisp Ellert Fund

- Grant application must promote visual art appreciation and/or visual art education in St. Augustine.
- Awards of up to \$5,000 will be made for work lasting up to one year; grant contracts begin October 15, 2015.
- Preliminary applications are due by **May 15, 2015**. Applicants will be notified by June 1, 2015 if they are eligible to make a full grant application.
