Individual Artists—Art Ventures

- The Community Foundation seeks to invest in individual artists who are pursuing the next step in their artistic development
- Grants of up to \$3,500 will be awarded for one year
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and reside in Duval, Clay, Nassau, St. Johns or Baker County
- Applications due by **April 5, 2017** for grants beginning August 1, 2017

Visual Arts in St. Augustine—Dr. JoAnn Crisp-Ellert Fund

- Grant application must promote visual art appreciation and/or visual art education in St. Augustine
- Awards of up to \$5,000 to nonprofit organizations will be made for work lasting up to one year; grant contracts begin August 15, 2017
- Preliminary applications are due by **April 12, 2017**
