Early Childhood

Early Childhood (Children 0-6): *to support the growth of creative and efficient services to at-risk children under six. A focus is on supporting early learning centers and parents*

Duval County Public Schools (DCPS): A grant for **\$13,855** to pilot a social-emotional/physical movement program for 700 at-risk three and four-year olds in seven Title I elementary schools.

Episcopal Children's Services (ECS): A grant for **\$15,000** to support full implementation of the CLASS approach for Infants and Toddlers in its Jacksonville Early Head Start Centers in Duval County.

I.M.Sulzbacher Center's Crawford Early Learning Center: A grant for **\$15,000** to purchase a trauma-informed curriculum for all its age groups as well as teacher training and an assessment tool.

Episcopal Children's Services: A grant for **\$1,000** to purchase license and materials needed to pilot a new training program to help parents support their children in developing warm and supportive relationships in two Early Head Start Centers.

Hope Haven Association, Inc.: A grant for **\$1,000** to support staff attending the 10th Annual Autism Symposium on "Current and Medical Evidence and Interventions Regarding Autism."

Jacksonville School for Autism: A grant for **\$1,000** to adapt and create interactive books for students between two and five years old with autism.

Palms Preschool and Childcare Center: A grant for **\$1,000** to purchase training materials for its expansion to include a toddler classroom.
