- Grants of up to \$20,000 will be made for work for one year

Open to individual artists who are pursuing the next step in their artistic development

- Grants of up to \$3,500 will be awarded for one year
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and reside in Duval, Clay, Nassau, St. Johns or Baker County
- Applications due by **March 12, 2019** for grants beginning August 1, 2019

Early Childhood—Closing Soon!

Open to nonprofit organizations who provide services to at-risk children in Duval County, primarily through work with parents and caregivers

- Grants of up to \$15,000 available for one year
- Children served must be between 0-6 years of age in Duval County
