2020

- A grant for **\$150,000** to **ElderSource (Northeast Florida Area Agency on Aging)** to provide financial assistance for aging adults in crisis.

2019

Aging Adults- *to improve the quality of life for aging adults*

- A grant for **\$20,000** to **Beaches Emergency Assistance Ministry (BEAM)** to expand services for seniors in need through case management and volunteers who will provide light housekeeping, transportation, and minor home repairs. This will help an estimated 75 seniors in the beaches area to live independently in their homes.
- A grant for **\$11,000** to **Brooks Health Foundation** to train professionals in a fall prevention method called *Stepping On*.
- A grant for **\$18,500** to **ElderSource (Northeast Florida Area Agency on Aging)** to provide seniors affected by Alzheimer's disease and related dementias with access to memory-enhancing activities. ElderSource, in partnership with Mayo, will organize two hours of memory café programming per month at various sites in New Town serving an estimated 120-180 patient-caregiver pairs over the grant period.
- A grant for **\$20,000** to **Pine Castle** to implement a form of memory therapy called, "Reminiscence Therapy" by installing murals and props in a dedicated wing of their facility.
- A grant for **\$20,000** to **St. John's County Council on Aging** to expand its Community Care-Giving Program which will provide educational workshops, support groups and self-care activities (yoga, mindful meditation) to caregivers with a loved-one suffering from dementia and extend services into hard-to-reach areas of St. Johns County, such as Hastings.

2020 Grants to nonprofits serving Aging Adults will be announced by September 1, 2020.
