Nina Waters currently serves as President of The Community Foundation for Northeast Florida, Inc. The Community Foundation for Northeast Florida is Florida's oldest community foundation, and with assets of more than \$630 million, is the state's largest. She was promoted to this position in January 2005 after serving as Executive Vice President for three years. Her primary responsibilities include the leadership and management of the donor services, grantmaking services and administrative services functions of the Foundation. Accomplishments include launching the Foundation's Quality Education for All initiative in 2005, which led to the creation of the Jacksonville Public Education Fund, and culminated in the announcement of a \$38 million fund for local education investment. Nina also assisted in the development of the Women's Giving Alliance, the Foundation's first giving circle, in 2001. Under her leadership, Foundation assets have more than quadrupled and annual grants to the community have grown from \$9M in 2002 to nearly \$50M annually.

Prior to joining the staff of the Foundation, Nina served as Executive Director for the PACE Center for Girls Jacksonville program for twelve years. Prior to leaving PACE in 2001, Nina completed a \$2.5 million capital campaign for the PACE Jacksonville program, assisted in the oversight of the construction of the new 20,000 square foot facility and facilitated the relocation of the program to the Thompson-Weaver campus on University Blvd. North.
